Fresh as a bowl of strawberries with gentle, tongue tingling fizz, think of it as a life affirming glass of cheer whenever the fancy takes you		
3. Champagne, France Champagne Drappier Carte d'Or Brut NV 		£55.00
A Pinot Noir-based champagne of style and finesse, it offers delicate aromas of white peach, quince and a touch of spice. The dry, elegant palate shows an impressive degree of concentration, along with fine bubbles and a long, crisp finish.		
4. Champagne, France Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial NV 		£70.00
Golden straw yellow with green highlights and the vibrant intensity of green apple and citrus fruit.		
5. Champagne, France Laurent-Perrier La Cuvée NV 		£75.00
Fresh and easy on the palate, with a creamy mousse and notes of honeysuckle, ripe peach, citrus and a slight toasty note on the finish. Well balanced with a fresh acidity.		
6. Champagne, France Bollinger Special Cuvée NV 		£80.00
Bone dry, full bodied Champagne with a mature, toasty flavour and rich aroma.		
7. Champagne, France Laurent-Perrier Rosé NV 		£90.00
Salmon pink in the glass with full raspberry and cherry notes carried on a long stream of fine bubbles.		
8. Champagne, France Dom Pérignon 2010 		£200.00
It's a complex and silky wine with rich flavours of brioche, ripe pear and hazelnut.		
9. Champagne, France Louis Roederer Cristal 2012 		£285.00
An impressive vintage for Cristal with linear precision and so much detail that it leaves the palate tingling. Layers of flavours and impeccable precision!

Fresh floral aroma and crisp ripe fruit on the palate. A dry, easy-drinking style.			
11. Sicily, Italy Montalto Organic Pinot Grigio 	£6.00	£12.00	£22.00
Exotic, offering fresh, clean fruity notes of pear, green apple and white peaches.			
12. Aegean, Turkey Majestik Sauvignon/Sultaniye, Sevilen 	£7.00	£13.00	£25.00
The wine offers floral notes alongside flavours of green apple, grapefruit and some tropical hints. Full-bodied yet refreshing and round, with a crisp and balanced finish.			
13. Tokaj, Hungary Dry Furmint, Sauska 	£8.00	£15.00	£28.00
This is Hungary's most famous white grape variety, this Furmint offers intense aromas of peach, blood orange and herbs. The palate is dry, leading to a crisp grapefruity finish.			
14. Galicia, Spain Serra da Estrela Albariño 			£30.00
Displaying typical Albariño character and aromatic richness, this surprisingly intense wine shows hints of pear, apricot and ripe exotic fruits complemented by a vibrant citrus character and hints of mineral and spice.			
14. Anatolia, Turkey Nativus Narince, Sevilen 			£34.00
Delicate floral and citrus notes on the nose lead onto a medium-bodied palate with flavours of white peaches and apricots. The ripe fruit is lifted by the bright acidity.			
16. South Island, New Zealand Mahi Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc 			£36.00
Musky aromas and flavors of lemon-lime, pepper and herbs, plus a suggestion of ripe peach. Plush and broad but with harmonious spicy, grapefruit notes giving the wine lift.			
17. Marches, Italy Verdicchio di Matelica, Bisci 			£34.00
Intense flavours of white flowers and crisp green apples with an appealing bitter note on the finish. Textured and rich, but with an appealing freshness.			
18. Loire, France Sancerre, Domaine Cherrier 			£49.00
Fresh citrus on the nose, with a palate of melon and stone fruit balanced with subtle grassy notes and some bright minerality.			
19. Burgundy, France Chablis 1er Cru Montmains, Brocard 			£60.00
Spicy notes with flint and citrus fruit aromas on the nose, followed by a subtle palate showing beautiful minerality and notes of lemon.

A delicate rosé, with lifted aromas of spring flowers and strawberries, red berry fruit on the palate and a soft, round finish.			
21. California, USA Golden State Zinfandel Rosé 	£7.00	£13.00	£25.00
Fruity aromas and flavours of ripe red fruit, cranberries and watermelon. The palate has a gentle sweetness with a refreshing acidity that prevents it from becoming cloying.			
22. Provence, France Saint-Roch Les Vignes Rosé, Les Maîtres Vignerons 	£8.50	£15.00	£30.00
A pale salmon hue with notes of white peaches and lychees on the nose. Fresh and lively on the palate, fairly light in body, with a refreshing dry finish.			
23. Provence, France Whispering Angel, Côtes de Provence Rosé 			bottle £45.00 magnum £85.00
The palest of pale pinks, this delicate rosé, offers a core of pretty stone fruit with herbal notes. The palate is dry, but smooth-textured, with a mineral finish.

Vibrant berry and spice aromas; smooth in the mouth with cherry and raspberry flavours.			
25. Chile Morandé Pionero Merlot Reserva 	£6.00	£12.00	£22.00
This beautifully balanced Merlot combines smooth ripe plum and raspberry fruit with cinnamon spice and a neat medium-bodied texture, finishing on notes of dark chocolate.			
26. Turkey Majestik Syrah/Kalecik Karasi, Sevilen 	£7.00	£13.00	£25.00
The Syrah's firmer structure is moderated by the round and fruity Kalecik Karasi to give a balanced, medium-bodied wine with flavours of strawberries and mulberries and a hint of pepper and spice on the finish.			
27. Argentina Organic Passo Doble Tierra Soleada Masi, Tupungato 	£8.00	£15.00	£28.00
Super-ripe berry fruit, dried plums and vanilla on the nose. Rich and concentrated on the palate, with a soft, smooth texture and a generous fruit-filled finish.			
28. Spain La Transición Garnacha, Soto Manrique 			£30.00
Red fruit flavours give way to gentle tannins and a bright seam of acidity. There are subtle herbal notes to complement the fruit, but balance and elegance.			
29. Victoria, Australia Mathilda Shiraz, Tournon 			£35.00
Deep black fruit flavours on the nose follow through onto the palate, where they are supported by elegant and silky tannins. Spicy and savoury, with notes of black pepper and earth.			
30. Aegean, Turkey Nativus Bogazkere/Öküzgözü, Sevilen 			£35.00
The Öküzgözü brings fleshy berry fruit flavours, whilst the Bogazkere provides tannin and structure, darker fruit flavours and notes of liquorice and black pepper. Bold, bright and fruit-forward, with a long, harmonious finish.			
31. Aconcagua, Chile Morandé Pinot Noir Gran Reserva 			£37.50
A pure and impressive single-vineyard Pinot Noir, which offers layer upon layer of raspberry, strawberry, fresh red cherry and summer flowers. Medium-bodied and silky.			
32. Abruzzo, Italy Jorio Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Umani Ronchi 			£39.00
Flavours of ripe plums and red cherries give way to balsamic and savoury notes. The palate is full-bodied, with plush, velvety tannins, with subtle notes of liquorice and spice.			
33. Rioja, Spain Cantos de Valpiedra, Rioja 			£42.50
An intense aroma combining ripe sloes and blackfruit with a mineral lift and cigar box /vanilla notes from the oak. Silky-textured and fresh in the mouth, with ample fruit fleshing out the supple structure.			
34. Bordeaux, France Château Perron, Lalande-de-Pomerol 			£59.00
Supple and fleshy, with the generous plum/berry fruit of the appellation's Merlot, lifted by a seam of mineral elegance and some fresh currant notes from the Cabernets.			
35. Tuscany, Italy Brunello di Montalcino, Pian delle Vigne Antinori 2015 			£100.00
Complex, generous nose with ripe aromas of cherries and raspberries, light tobacco notes and hints of coffee and cocoa powder. Multi-layered structure with a nicely rounded texture and elegant fruit leading to a very long finish.			

37. Tokaj, Hungary Tokaji Late Harvest Cuvée, Sauska 	500ml bottle	£50.00
Gorgeously rich yet precisely balanced, this classic Tokaji presents flavours of dried peach, apricot and toffee, plus a zesty citrus note. There is intensity and power here, but a lightness of touch that makes it decidedly moreish.		xxml £11.00
38. Douro, Portugal Ferreira Tawny Port NV 	750ml bottle	£35.00
